#### **ICE BREAKER**

What is the greatest breakfast item of all time?

#### <u>OVERVIEW</u>

"Today, we're talking about sin, but not just any sin; hidden sin. This is something that scripture talks a lot about. The major problem with hidden sin (or secret sin) is that it lives in an environment where it can flourish - the dark. When sin gets left unconfessed, it begins to grow bigger and bigger until it's something that we can no longer control - then it begins to control us. Today, we're going to discuss the power in confessing our sins to God and to trusted Christians. Not only does God forgive us when we repent and are honest about our brokenness, but He also gives us the strength to overcome."

#### **ANCHOR VERSE**

"If we <u>confess</u> our sins, he is faithful and just and will <u>forgive us our sins</u> and <u>purify us from all unrighteousness</u>."

- 2. Why do you think confession is so important? Read <u>1 John 1:9</u> again and discuss.
- 3. Why do you think it's important to confess to fellow Christians? *Read James 5:16* and discuss.

- 5. Do you think conviction by the Holy Spirit is good? Read <u>2 Corinthians 7:9-10</u> and discuss.
